The Parish Council have dedicated dog bins by the notice board on the Common, at the car park at the Youth and Community Building opposite Lythwood Sports Pavilion, at the entrance and exit of the Glebelands and by the Library. There are also bins provided at the Community Woodland. Can we please ask all dog owners to either put their dog waste in these bins or take it home with you. Thank you.
