All meetings are held in the Memorial Hall Annexe. Council meetings start at 7.30pm except for Parish that start at 7pm. All are welcome.

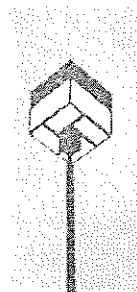

Alternatively, you can now log onto our website and complete a Report Form.

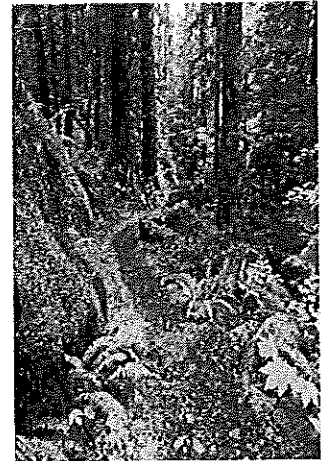
Synthetic Pitch at Sports Pavilion

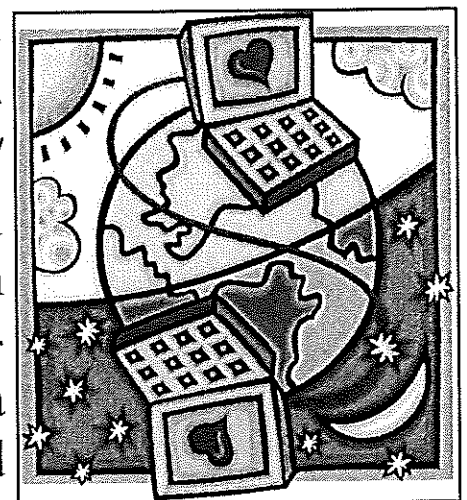
Parrs Pool Walkway

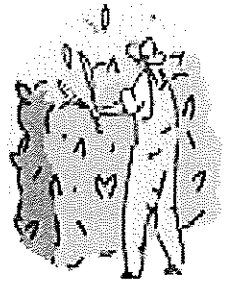


Youth and Community Building
